

# **EMT Certification Checklist**

**Step 1: Obtain NREMT Certification** 

**Step 2: EMT State Card** 

Apply for certification from a county EMS Agency within 2 years of EMT course completion Complete and Submit\_Request for LiveScan\_to the EMS county office Pay required application fees (fees will vary)

#### **Step 3: Medical Examiner's Certificate**

To be completed by a Health Care Provider. (A ME certificate is required before proceeding to step 4)

## **Step 4: Ambulance Driver Certificate**

Must have a valid CA Driver's License and pay application fee Pass a written exam Complete and submit a <u>Request for Livescan</u>

## **Complete list of requirements:**

Immunization Records: TB test (within 1 year if skin, 2 years if x-ray), Hep B, Varicella, MMR, and Flu shot

EMT State Card (California)

Valid CA Driver's License

Ambulance Driver's License

Medical Examiner's Certificate

Current American Heart Association BLS CPR card

Work Authorization Documentation

ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-700, Hazmat FRO

AWR-160

DMV K-4 Driving report (currently accepting online printout from DMV)
